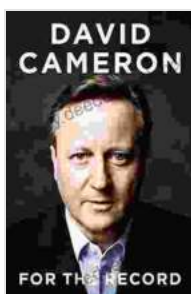


For The Record David Cameron

Political Career

Cameron began his political career in 1997, when he was elected to the House of Commons as the Member of Parliament (MP) for Witney. He served in the Shadow Cabinet under Michael Howard and David Davis, and became Leader of the Conservative Party in 2005.

In the 2010 general election, the Conservative Party won the most seats in the House of Commons, but fell short of an overall majority. Cameron

formed a coalition government with the Liberal Democrats, and became Prime Minister on May 11, 2010.

As Prime Minister, Cameron oversaw a period of economic recovery and austerity. He also introduced a number of social reforms, including the legalization of same-sex marriage in England and Wales.

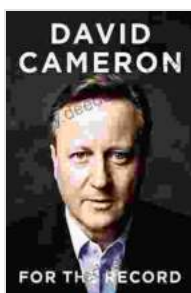

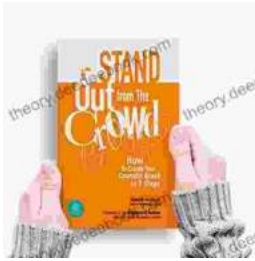
